# Setting the scene

Since the pandemic we've sharpened our focus to deliver primarily in Rochdale responding to the need in this area

86% of work takes place in the top 3-10% most deprived neighbourhoods in England

40.5% or 12 children in a classroom of 30 are living in poverty, which mean Rochdale has the 20<sup>th</sup> highest level of child poverty in the country
