<p>The decision is that:</p> <p>Approval is given to tender the contract for the supply of Grounds Maintenance using an open process.</p>
<p>The reasons for the decision are:</p> <p>Procurement legislation requires GMP to tender for these goods and services. The recommended route provides the most effective route to market.</p>
<p>Alternative options considered and rejected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do nothing – rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable’s Financial Instructions. • Use a framework – rejected as there is are no suitable frameworks available. • Extend current arrangements – rejected as amendments are required to the current contract.
<p>Financial comments:</p> <p>The estimated contract value is £150K per annum and there is appropriate budget provision for this.</p>
<p>Legal comments:</p> <p>The contract will be awarded as per the standard terms and conditions of the GMCA Mayor’s Office.</p> <p>These have been reviewed by the Force Contracts Solicitor and no issues have been identified.</p>


