<p>The decision is that:</p> <p>Approval is given to tender a framework for the supply of First Aid Training. The Framework shall be tendered in 1 LOT covering First Aid at Work, Emergency First Aid, Custody First Aid, and Firearms and Public Order requirements using an open tender. The framework will be for a 4 year term.</p> <p>GMP intends to use the framework to call-off its own contract for First Aid Training. This contract will be for 3 years, with the option to extend for a further 4 years.</p>
<p>The reasons for the decision are:</p> <p>Procurement legislation requires GMP to tender for these goods and services. The recommended route provides the most effective route to market.</p> <p>The framework and contract will enable the supply of First Aid Training courses for Police Officers and Staff, carrying out practical scenario training and continued annual refresher courses in core skills and scenarios. The courses provided will include First Aid at Work, Emergency First Aid, Custody First Aid, and Firearms and Public Order requirements.</p>
<p>Alternative options considered and rejected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do nothing – rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable’s Financial Instructions. • Use a framework – rejected as there is no suitable framework available. • Extend current arrangements – rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable’s Financial Instructions.

Financial comments:

The estimated contract value for GMP is £250K per annum. The current budget is approximately £200k per annum. The estimated value for the new contract is based on the additional requirements following the Arena Enquiry and the Police Uplift Programme. The costs will be refined through the tender process.

Legal comments:

The contract will be awarded as per the standard terms and conditions of the GMCA Mayor's Office Standard.

These have been reviewed by the Force Contracts Solicitor and no issues have been identified.

Risk Assessment:

As this is a compliant route to market there is no risk of a challenge to the tender process.
