<p>The decision is that:</p> <p>£200 be awarded to ManKind Initiative for the Chairing of the inaugural GM Male DA Working Group in September 2022 and the preparation and planning which took place ahead of this meeting.</p>
<p>The reasons for the decision are:</p> <p>Greater Manchester published it’s Gender-Based Violence Strategy in September 2021. Within this there was a commitment to look at the needs of male victims of Gender-Based Violence. The convening of a GM Male DA working group is integral to this and will assist with developing the response to male victims of domestic abuse across Greater Manchester.</p> <p>ManKind Initiative contributed to the development of the terms of reference for this working group, a scoping exercise undertaken to identify what current provision looked like across Greater Manchester and the Chairing of the first meeting. It was agreed a £200 one-off payment would be given to ManKind in recognition of the value of their contribution to getting the working group to a strong and productive start.</p>
<p>This decision will contribute to priorities of the the Greater Manchester strategy in the following ways:</p> <p>This will contribute to the following Police, Crime and Fire actions for the GMS Delivery Plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tackle gender-based violence and abuse in all its forms.

- Gender-based Violence Strategy.
