<p>The decision is that:</p> <p>Approval is given to tender for the supply of Tactical Communications and Hearing Protection using an open tender procedure. The contract will be for 5 years, with the option to extend for a further 5 years. The likely value for GMP of 10 years spend would be circa £538k.</p>
<p>The reasons for the decision are:</p> <p>Procurement legislation requires GMP to tender for these goods and services. The recommended route provides the most effective route to market.</p>
<p>Alternative options considered and rejected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do nothing – rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable’s Financial Instructions. • Use a framework - rejected as there are none available.
<p>Financial comments:</p> <p>The initial purchase is estimated at £430K for which a capital marker has been approved. The revenue contract value is circa £12k.</p>
<p>Legal comments:</p> <p>The contract will be awarded as per the standard terms and conditions of the GMCA.</p> <p>These have been reviewed by the Force Contracts Solicitor and no issues have been identified.</p>
