The decision is that:

The Deputy Mayor approves the direct award of a 4 year and 6 month contract for the provision of the data warehouse reporting tool and legacy data store, to Capita Consulting, with the option to extend for a further 2×1 year. The likely value of 6.5 years spend would be circa £2.03m.

The reasons for the decision are:

Procurement legislation requires GMP to award a new contract for these goods and services. The recommended route of the CCS RM6259 framework, Lot 5: Blue Light Solutions framework, provides the most effective route to market.

Alternative options considered and rejected:

- Do nothing rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable's Financial Instructions.
- Undertake a bespoke procurement exercise (OJEU) –rejected as there is a suitable framework available.
- Extend current arrangements rejected as non-compliant with Procurement Legislation and Chief Constable's Financial Instructions.

Financial comments:

The cost of this contract will be circa £2.03m and there is appropriate provision for this in the current budget.

Legal comments:

The contract will be awarded using the CCS RM6259 framework.
