A payment of £189.80 to be made to the APCC for the National Chaplaincy Service for the period of 2021/2022 and 2022/2023. The funding will be allocated from the Police and Crime Commissioners budget.

The reasons for the decision are:

At the APCC AGM in July 2016, the vast majority of PCCs agreed to fund the National Police Chaplaincy Service on an ongoing basis.

This decision will contribute to priorities of the Greater Manchester strategy in the following ways:

The National Police Chaplaincy Service plays a significant role in coordinating the role of police chaplains of all faiths in supporting the wellbeing of police officers and police staff. The National Chaplain supports the workforce following major/critical incidents and helps facilitate community recovery. The National Chaplain provides support at key events celebrating and remembering the outstanding commitment of the workforce such as the National Police Bravery Awards and the National Police Memorial Day.
