<p><b>The decision is that:</b></p> <p>£15,000 be allocated to the development of the Police and Crime Plan – this will be used for the holding of 4 external engagement events and for procuring the designing of the Plan once a draft has been finalised.</p>
<p><b>The reasons for the decision are:</b></p> <p>The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 sets out the detail which must be included in a police and crime plan which has to be issued in the financial year following the election of the Mayor.</p> <p>Considering and taking into account the views of GM residents, victims of crime and responsible authorities is an integral part of developing the plan – which the holding of engagement events will support.</p> <p>The final Plan will need to be designed and published on the GMCA website and therefore needs to be professionally designed and finished. The document needs to appeal to a variety of audiences, be accessible and will run until 2029 so quality of design is important.</p>
<p><b>This decision will contribute to priorities of the Greater Manchester strategy in the following ways:</b></p> <p>The Police and Crime Plan is the document which outlines how the Mayor will tackle crime and community safety over the period of his appointment.</p>

It also details how policing and community safety services will contribute to the wider objectives of the Greater Manchester strategy.


