1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1.1. At its meeting on 14 May 2021 the Panel resolved to agree in principle to appoint five local authority co-opted members to meet the balanced appointment objective and to seek the Secretary of State's agreement to that proposal.

2. CURRENT POSITION

- 2.1. Following the meeting a request was submitted to the Secretary of State and formal agreement was received in the attached letter dated 10 December 2021 from the Minister of State for Crime, Policing and Probation.
- 2.2. Nominations have been received from political groups as to the members they wish to be co-opted to the Panel, as follows
 - i. Tom Morrison (Stockport) Liberal Democrat
 - ii. Russell Bernstein (Bury) Conservative
 - iii. Dylan Butt (Trafford) Conservative
 - iv. Rabiya Jiva (Bolton) Labour
 - v. Awaiting confirmation of co-optee (Labour)
- 2.3. This would increase the membership of the Panel to 17 members in total.
