Purpose of Report:

This report presents the GM Recovery Strategy for discussion. Whilst it has its origins in the GM Provider Federation Board operating model, it has been shaped by significant system engagement so that it presents a broad view of the challenges associated with recovering our services and the main themes for action over the next three years. It has been endorsed by the Joint Planning and Delivery Committee.

The document presents a summary of the collaborative action that will be undertaken across GM, setting out the main priorities and sequence of those actions planned to address our key service challenges. Whilst it includes themes drawn from local recovery plans, it does not represent the totality of recovery action, most of which will naturally happen within each of the 10 Places.

This document summarises what are much more comprehensive plans supporting each of the eight key work programmes, acknowledging the governance arrangements associated with each of them and complements the emerging ICS strategy.

Recommendations:

1. Discuss the GM Strategic Approach to Recovery, noting the scale and interconnectivity of the proposed.
2. Comment on whether this provides a practical joined-up framework for delivery.
