PURPOSE OF REPORT

In June 2022, the Police and Crime Panel considered and agreed a framework for receiving reports of performance against the Standing Together Police and Crime Plan 2022-25.

It was agreed that the Panel would receive separate updates providing a summary of progress against each of the priorities of the plan. This update provides a summary of progress against Priority 1 of the plan – Keeping People Safe and Supporting Victims.

In addition, a performance scorecard is provided to every meeting and a programme of deep dive thematic reports scheduled across the year to Panel and Steering Group.

The report covers the following commitments:

- Improve access to police service
- Improve Police responsiveness and visibility
- Improve services to victims
- Improve services to victims of sexual violence and domestic abuse
- Protect vulnerable people from criminal exploitation
- Protect vulnerable young people
- Improve how police, criminal justice, and community safety services work with mental health services

Through consultation, the public told us what they wanted the plan to deliver, these are identified by "You asked us" and the plan identified key outcomes to be achieved by the end of the plan.

All Community Safety Partnerships have received grant allocations and agreements for 2022-23 for grants as set out below:

- VCSE
- Hate Crime
- Core Serious Violence
- Serious Violence Prevention

In addition, the GMCA Police, Fire and Crime team are working closely with district Community Safety Partnerships through identified Partnership Link officers.
