


Annex A5 – Moving Towards a Circular Economy



Moving Towards a Circular Economy Flow Chart describing the Recommendations in the SCP Plan; 1- To develop a roadmap to CE, including cross industry resource efficiency through design and production, commercial trading of materials, energy, sharing assets, logistics and expertise, to reduce the volume of raw materials used and eliminate waste; 2 – To continue to work with industry, academia and other stakeholders to drive innovation to reduce raw material consumption, value resources and stimulate sustainable end markets; 3 – To undertake resource and consumption mapping to enable a sector approach to becoming a circular city region; 4 GMCA to develop a Sustainable Procurement Strategy promoting CE procurement principles, the social value framework and commissioning strategies whilst supporting policy development and decision making toolkits. Targets and KPIs include a 38% reduction in industry emissions by 2025, a reduction in Raw Material Consumption, to reduce GHG emissions from Consumption and a Reduction in avoidable plastic waste.
